The countries taking part in the programme include Bulgaria, The Czech Republic, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Moldova, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Spain, The Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Turkey and Ukraine.
